Power and O.G. Original Gangster developed Ice-T's method beyond shock. He could portray criminal confidence, interrupt it with analysis, then turn toward responsibility or survival. New Jack Hustler, Colors, and the title track O.G. are cinematic records, but the best moments also reveal an author examining how power is manufactured and lost.

O.G. Original Gangster also introduced Body Count, making rap and metal coexist inside one project rather than treating genre as a border. That move anticipated later rap-rock hybrids and clarified that Ice-T's creative identity was built around narrative intensity, not one instrumental formula.
