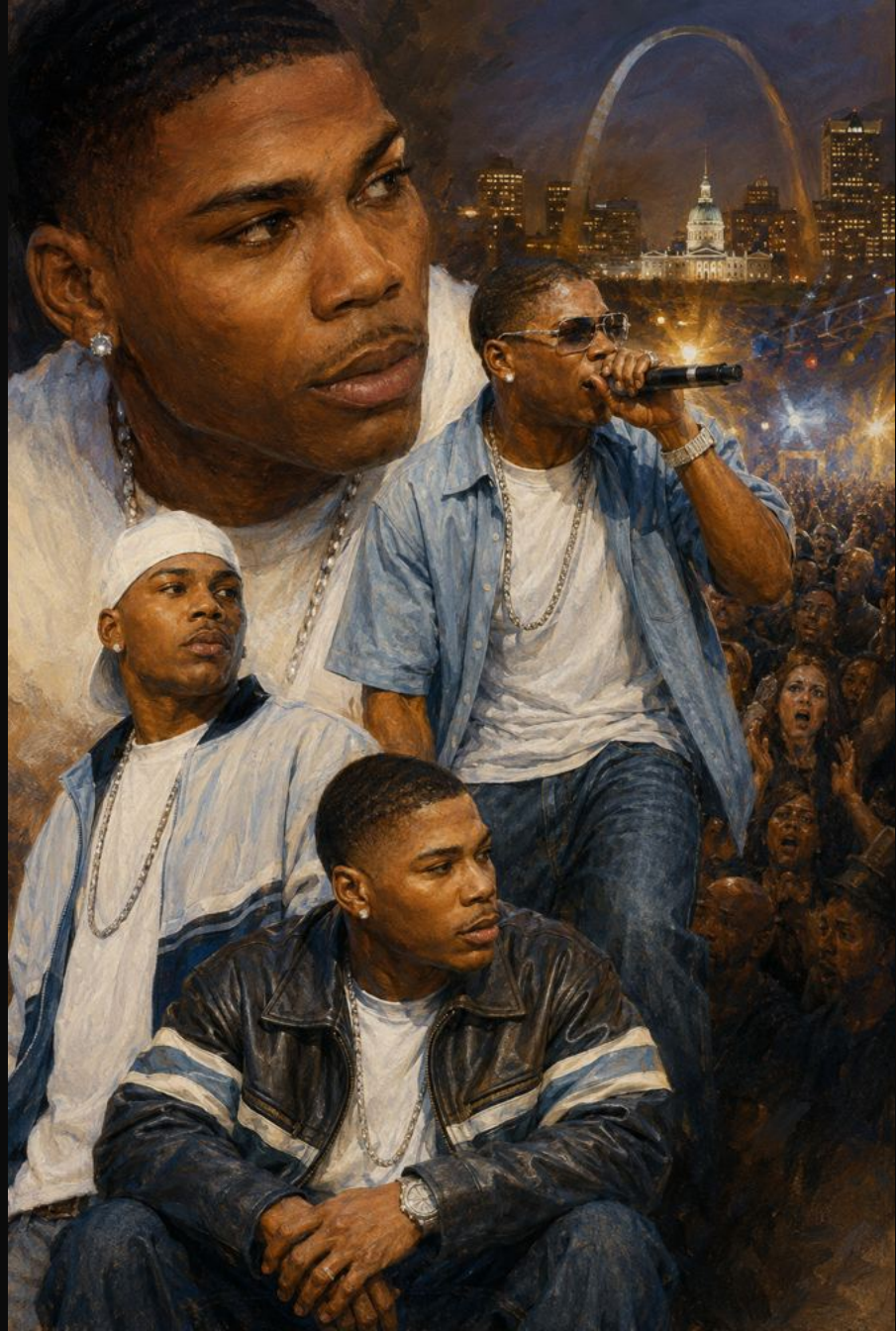




Nelly

Country Grammar became an enormous debut because Nelly's sing-song cadence felt instantly familiar and unmistakably regional. The title track, E.I., and Ride Wit Me balanced neighborhood detail with hooks that traveled across radio formats.

The success placed St. Louis on hip-hop's commercial map without forcing it into East Coast, West Coast, or Southern categories. Nelly's accent itself became production—a rhythmic instrument listeners imitated.
