Then & Now

The young Queen Latifah arrived in African-inspired crowns and structured silhouettes, insisting that femininity in rap did not have one approved shape. The mature artist moves among drama, comedy, music, hosting, production, and entrepreneurship with the same refusal of a narrow role.

Recognition followed: major acting honors and nominations, a Hollywood Walk of Fame star, and Kennedy Center celebration. Yet the through-line is less trophy than control—control of voice, image, tone, and the range of stories a Black woman can lead.
